Visitors and Conference Guests attending any University-sponsored event and/or program must complete a **PennOpen Campus** pre-screening **EVERY** day while accessing University classrooms and food & beverage venues. You must present a Green Pass on request.

The University requests that visitors not come physically to campus if they feel ill or have been recently exposed to a case of COVID-19. Although not required ***at this time***, it's strongly encouraged for visitors to be up-to-date with their COVID-19 vaccinations and related boosters.

As a conference attendee, we implore you to remain vigilant as you have the potential to impact 37,000 Penn students, Faculty, staff, postdocs and the surrounding West Philadelphia community.

Individual schools and centers manage their visitor experience and may establish more strict policies regarding mask use, physical distancing, and eating/drinking by visitors inside their campus buildings. That being said, mask wearing is currently mandatory in classrooms. How this might affect you in June has yet to be determined.

As you all are aware, the needle on protection/reduction in positivity rates changes almost daily. We at Penn simply ask for you to do the right thing.

Again, it is likely things may change again. You will be updated.
